5. PROGRAMME

- * Professionals will be required to compete in all 5 dances from the Quarter-Final.
- ** Amateurs will be required to compete in all 5 dances from the final Qualifying Heats.

In the Japan International Dancing Championships, 14 couples will be recalled in the Semi-Final and 7 couples in the Final.

The couples selected to dance in the Final will be required to perform one solo dance following the prescribed basic amalgamation.

Judging will be based on “all-round” efficiency in all dances.

6. ENTRY QUALIFICATIONS OF OVERSEAS COUPLES

1. Japan International Dancing Championships (Open to the World)

PROFESSIONAL

There are three categories with regard to the conditions for overseas professional couples:

Invited Couples A* (Standard & Latin)	The Organiser will bear travel expenses and accommodation fees in accordance with rules stipulated for up to three couples. The relevant couples have already been selected and informed by the Organiser. competitors are exempt from the participation registration fee.
Invited Couples B** (Standard & Latin)	The Organiser will bear accommodation fees for three nights. competitors are exempt from the participation registration fee.
Others C** (Standard & Latin)	The Organiser will not bear any expenses. (Other than A & B above) Arrival of airplanes and hotel arrangements for traveling must be done by all competitors . Participation registration fee is 10,000 yen, and you must deposit it in Japanese yen at the same time as applying for participation. After application, we will not refund participation registration fee even if cancellation of participation. All professional dancers need to take VISA , so please let us know by the dead line.

* Invited Couples A* or professional competitors who have placed semifinal in the international competitions will be seeded and compete from the Second Qualifying Heats. International competitions refer to these competitions ;2018 British Open Festival , 2018 International Championships , 2018 WDC Open World Championship Professional Ballroom/Latin , 2019 United Kingdom Open Championships.

** The Organiser will inform you of the category (B or C) you are in when you apply for the entry.

※ 【 About doping inspection】

For the professional department, it will be a competition subject to designation of doping examination based on the World Anti-Doping Rules. If it is specified by the World Anti-Doping Organization, it will be an inspection competition. Therefore, at the time of applying for participation in this competition, we regard as agreeing to the doping inspection. In addition, if a minor applies for participation in this competition, it is assumed that the consent of the parental author is obtained concerning the doping inspection implementation. Participating competitors of this competition shall not complete the doping inspection procedure due to refusal or avoidance of doping tests conducted at this competition, failure to comply with the inspector's instructions, personal circumstances such as returning to the home ,if it can not be done, there is a possibility of violating the anti-doping rule. If judged to be an anti-doping rule violation, please be aware that it will be subject to sanctions etc. according to the World Anti-Doping Rules. AMATEURES

Open to all couples who are Amateurs.

2. Grand Senior Championships (Open to the World)

Open to all couples who are Amateurs.

Gentleman must be 55 years of age or over on the date of the competition.

Lady's age will be no subject.

3. Senior Championships (Open to the World)

Open to all couples who are Amateurs.

Gentleman and Lady must be 35 years of age or over on the date of the competition.

4. Junior Competitions (Open to the World)

Open to all amateur couples who are over 12 and under 16 years of age.

Either of a couple may be under 12 years of age.

Please bring your passport with you on the day of competition so that the Organiser can certify your age.

Junior couples can apply to upper grade competition with a written consent of their parents. Entry application can not be accepted without the written consent.

5. Juvenile Competitions (Open to the World)

Open to all amateur couples who are under 12 years of age.

Please send a copy of your passport with entry application and bring your passport with you on the day of competition to certify your age. In case of couples who are under 8 years of age, a written consent of their parents is needed. Juvenile couples can apply to upper grade competition with a written consent. Entry application can not be accepted without the written consent. The figure and dress regulations will be applied. 7. POLICY RESPONSES TO SAFETY CONCERNS

1. Before and during the event, health care at the self-responsibility should be done, please take care of yourself with full attention.
2. First Aid personnel shall be in attendance at all competitions. JBDF will not be legally liable in any circumstances.

8. HONOUR DANCE

Professional couples who win the First, Second, and Third places in the Japan International Dancing Championships will be required to perform the HONOUR DANCE in the specified dance.

9. PORTRAIT RIGHTS

The Organiser will reserve all portrait rights of the competitors and reserve all rights to any reproduction of any scene of the events in any form.

10. ADJUDICATORS

1. The panel of adjudicators for the Japan International Dancing Championships will consist of 11 or more adjudicators including overseas adjudicators for both Standard and Latin.
2. The Organiser will bear travel expenses and accommodation fees by rules. Details are written in the contract agreement.
